New Dog Law as of 2024

Any client that is out of state that is coming in for boarding, must have a current health certificate from their veterinarian.

The health certificate must be signed by your veterinarian.

For example: If you are here for the summer this health certificate will only be acceptable for 60 days, after 60 days you will be required to get a new health certificate.

All dogs must have a rabies certificate that is signed by your veterinarian on file. Please see our sample on our website or ask a team member if you have questions.

Vaccine Requirements

DHLPPC (Distemper)

Bordetella (Kennel Cough)

Rabies

All vaccines must be up to date and proof submitted to us 10 days or more before boarding.

Cat Vaccine Requirements

FVRCP (Distemper)
Feline Leukemia

Rabies

If you want your kitty to run free in the cattery, then a Negative Feluk/FIV is required.

Must present proof for all of the above.

Other Pet Vaccines

Pets such as pocket pets, ferrets, birds and rabbits. Are required to have no vaccines or very minimal. These pets are only required to have what is required by your vet.

For Example:

Ferrets, only get Distemper & Rabies while a Birds gets no vaccines. It is important and required to have the Bordetella vaccine administered at least 10 days prior to boarding.

If your pet is not vaccinated for bordetella, get them vaccinated today.

Pennsylvania Dog Law

Dog Law & Your Pet

All dogs three months of age or older must be licensed.

<u>Licenses</u> are issued by the <u>County Treasurer</u>

All dogs must be under control and must not be allowed to run at large. Dogs are personal property, and owners are responsible for damages caused their dog.

It is illegal to abandon or attempt to abandon any dog.

Owners of dogs and cats 3 months of age or older are required to have a current rabies vaccination. It is illegal to interfere with an officer or employee of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture engaged in enforcement of dog laws.

What to expect on your first visit

Your first visit to the kennel is the most important and time consuming.

It is important to make sure that you have everything for your pet that the kennel will need to make your pets stay an enjoyable experience.

When you arrive, if you haven't already done so, you will be asked to fill out our information form. This form is very important, as it contains the necessary information on you and your pet. We can then enter the required information into our computer system.

Once entered we will confirm pertinent information on your pets stay.

You may visit your pet during his/her stay if you are visiting the area. These visits are limited to Taking you pet out for a while or visiting with them in the designated guest area as to not disturb the kennel counselors attending to our other guest.

Lastly, we ask that you inform us of any important information on your pet (i.e. habits, medical conditions etc.). These things can help us understand your pets better.

Vaccines Required For Boarding

<u>Canine</u>: Rabies, Distemper and Bordetella <u>Feline</u>: Rabies, Distemper and <u>Feline Leukemia or Negative Test</u>

Due to the overwhelming requests for boarding, the following fees apply to all reservations!

If you do not pickup on your scheduled date and you have to pickup the following morning, the half day discount no longer applies and you must pickup by 8:30am.

Pickup after 8:30am the following morning will result in an extra fee of \$15.00 for that day.

Extension of more than one day: \$15.00 fee for everyday after your original pickup date.

Early pickups will be charged at full scheduled stay

To ensure simplicity of feeding times, as well as making sure that your pet(s) have the proper amount of food for their stay.

All clients bringing their pet(s) to Camp KCS for Boarding or Daycare will be required to pre-package and label all their pet's feedings.

If you do not wish to pre-package your pet's food, Camp KCS Staff will be required to pre-package and label the food for you. The cost of Camp KCS Staff pre-packaging your food will be \$1.00 per bag/feeding.

Although house food is included, a pre-bag fee will also be charged for house food.

Appointment Cancellation

When you book your boarding appointment, you are holding a space on our calendar that is no longer available to our other clients. In order to be respectful, please call Camp KCS as soon as you know you will not be able to make your appointment.

If cancellation is necessary, we require that you call at least 72 hours (3 days) in advance. Appointments are in high demand, and your advanced notice will allow another clients access to that time.

How to Cancel Your Appointment

If you need to cancel your appointment, please call us at 570-646-6012. If necessary, you may leave a detailed voicemail message. We will return your call as soon as possible. You can also cancel via your client portal.

Late Cancellations/No-Shows

A cancellation is considered late when the appointment is cancelled less than 72 hours before the appointed time. A no-show is when a client misses a reservation without cancelling. In either case, we will charge your account \$15 per day, per kennel for that reservation.

Our Policy:

Once a No Show or non-cancellation happens, you may be required to leave a 25 to 50% deposit for all future reservations.
